



IT Team Co-Lead

Job purpose

To support the IT Team to triage our mission critical IT requirements as well as the ongoing maintenance and development of our IT tools and security practices. The IT Team Co-Leads are also responsible for spearheading new development projects, and ensuring sufficient IT team resources so that the wider Kiwiburn Team of volunteers receive timely support with their IT-related requests.

Key Responsibilities

- Help develop Kiwiburn's IT protocols and processes.
- Recruit and lead the Kiwiburn IT volunteer team.
- Manage Systems Administration decisions (AirTable, Google Workspace, Slack, Asana).
- Help develop and structure our Event Management System (EMS) database (in Airtable).
- Help maintain and develop a front-end portal for our EMS database.
- Be proactive in improving, adjusting, and helping develop our tech stack and security.
- Be available regularly year-round via email and Slack, or ensure there is adequate cover when unavailable.
